NOTICE OF APPEAL

TAKE NOTICE:

- THAT the Attorney General of Canada, the above named Appellant, hereby appeals to the Court of Appeal from part of the judgment of the Honourable Mr. Justice D. Ball, issued on the 15th day of December, 2006.
- THAT the following parts of the judgment are being appealed:
 - (a) The learned Chambers Justice's disposition of the application respecting the payment of legal fees to the Merchant Law Group.
- 3. THAT the source of the Appellant's right of appeal and the court's iurisdiction to entertain the appeal is:
 - (a) Section 7(2)(a) of The Court of Appeal Act, S.S. 2000, c. C-42.1.

- 4. THAT the appeal is taken upon the following grounds:
 - (a) That the learned Chambers Justice erred in law by considering issues that were not properly before the Court, namely, the provisions that relate to the payment of legal fees to the Merchant Law Group, including issues as to their interpretation.
 - (b) That the learned Chambers Justice erred in law in his interpretation of the provisions that relate to the payment of legal fees to the Merchant Law Group.
 - (c) That the learned Chambers Justice erred in law by making findings of fact and legal interpretations of the provisions that relate to the payment of legal fees to the Merchant Law Group on the basis of no evidence, inadmissible evidence and evidence not properly before the Court and disregarded evidence that was properly before the Court.
 - (d) That the learned Chambers Justice erred in law by finding that section 41 of *The Class Actions Act*, S.S. 2001, c. C-12.01 had any application to the approval of legal fees payable to the Merchant Law Group.

- THAT the Appellant requests the following relief: 5.
 - (a) That the within appeal be allowed and that the portion of judgment being appealed is set aside or quashed and an Order requiring the Merchant Law Group to submit to verification pursuant to the provisions that relate to the payment of legal fees to the Merchant Law Group.
 - (b) An Order directing that any matter in issue concerning the provisions that relate to the payment of legal fees to the Merchant Law Group be disposed of in the Court of Queen's Bench of Saskatchewan on proper notice, evidence and submissions.
